\*The 15% increase and decrease are only applicable under Labor Code § 4658 if the employer has 50 or more employees and whether or not a job offer was made to the injured worker. However, the exact amount of the 15% increase on permanent disability is entirely dependent upon the date of the employer's offer of modified work. For instance, if the employer tells the injured employee, before the permanent and stationary date, that they cannot return to work, then all of the permanent disability must be increased by 15%. However, if the employer waits until 30 days after the permanent and stationary date, then only the remaining permanent disability would be increased by 15%.
